The plains - Nice country surprises



The open countryside to the right of the Piave River, characterized by ample cultivations that open to the eye, deserve a deviation for the surprises they reserve to the curious and attentive visitor.



Returning towards Oderzo on the Postumia Road, you will pass **Gorgo al Monticano**, where you can admire the sixteenth century **Villa Revedin**, a complex with porticoed buildings, small churches, stables and a park with a hotel and restaurant.

You can then travel towards S. Polo di Piave and before **Ormelle** you can follow the directions for the **Templar Church**, an important Romanesque construction (twelfth century) characterized by the low portico in front of the nave and the beautiful bell-tower.

After Ormelle you will find the **Church of S. Giorgio** of Longobard origins, restructured between the fifteenth and seventeenth centuries, with a cycle of frescoes dating to 1466.



At **S. Polo di Piave** you can see the original **Villa Papadopoli**, nineteenth century building in English Gothic style with a splendid park.

At **Rai**, there are the remains of a tower of the tenth century, testimony of an old castle possibly erected on Roman remains. After this we reach **Cimadolmo**, an agricultural centre with its production of the famous Raboso wine, aged for at least three years, and the white asparagus of the "Protected Geographical Identification" brand, one of the most appreciated products of Trevisan cooking.

You can go on to the Postumia Road at **Ponte di Piave**, which is a wine-making and industrial centre that was completely reconstructed after 1918. From here you can go back to Treviso or depart for another journey
