



The eastern Marcav

The wine road of the Piave river - Among villas and vineyards



To conclude this journey of discovery around the Marca Trevigiana, what better idea than to travel along the second wine road of the Piave River, in search of farms, cantinas and wine bars where you can taste the DOC reds and whites: Cabernet, Pinot -white, grey and black, Merlot, Tocai, Verduzzo, Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay and Raboso.



The area of production expands to the territory east of Treviso that we have already visited, in the circuit between the Piave and Monticano Rivers. Leaving from Conegliano, and passing through Mareno di Piave, we arrive to Oderzo, then Gorgo al Monticano and Motta di Livenza before descending through Chiarano, Cessalto, and Salgareda. Towards the north we pass through Roncade, already introduced, from where you can depart for Breda di Piave and Maserada, returning to Cimadolmo and S. Polo



Of these localities, not yet mentioned, perhaps it is worth taking a trip to **Cessalto** and **Chiarano**, area rich in mineral springs, where there are still some splendid villas: **Villa Emo-Giacobini**, of the sixteenth century with its beautiful frescoes, and **Villa Zeno** built in 1565 on a plan drawn by Palladio: notwithstanding the continual restructuring (the back façade is original), the villa reveals a purity of line and represents the extreme limit to the east of the "Villa Civilization" that enriched the fabric of the Marca that disappears beyond the Livenza River.
